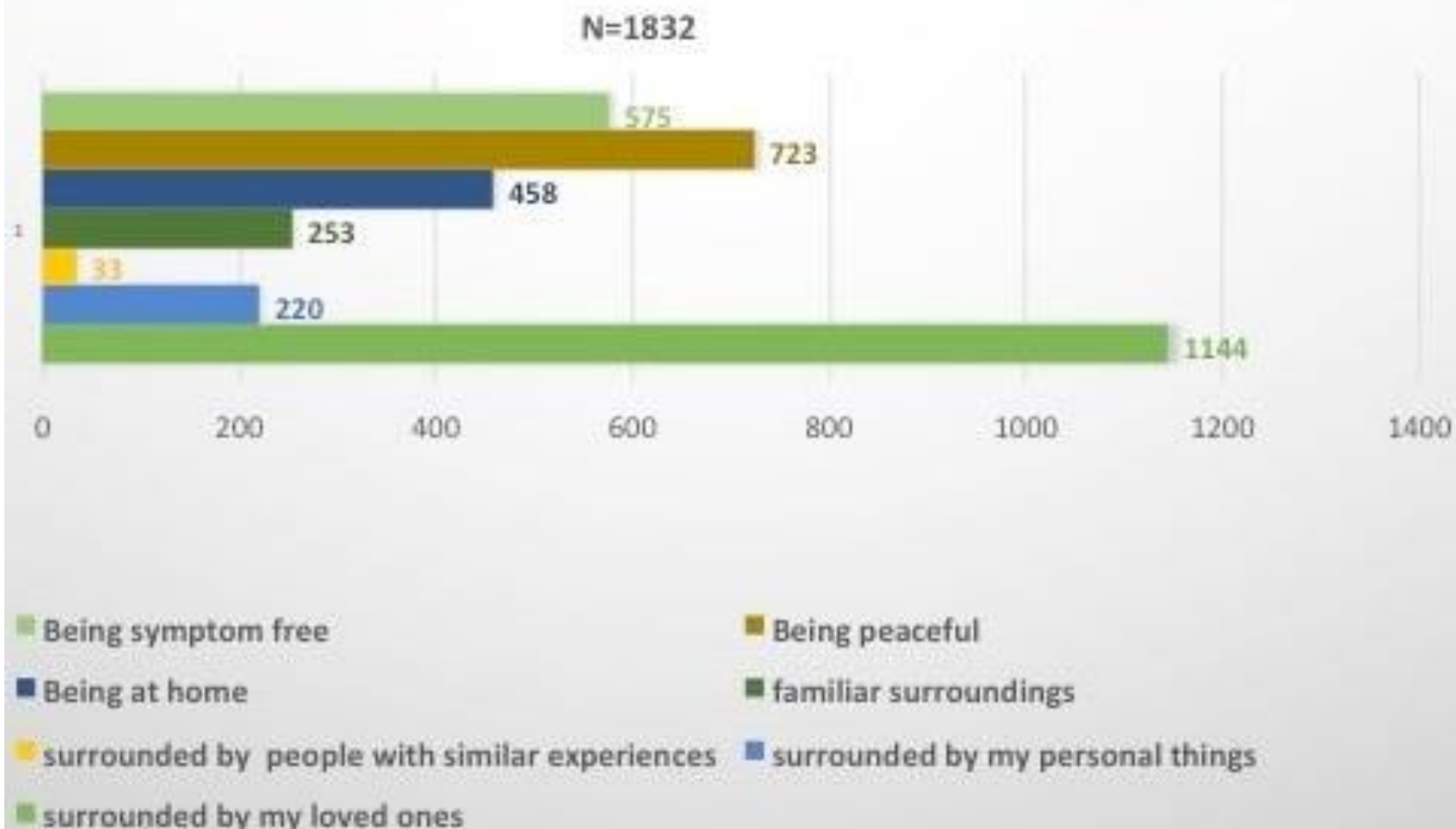

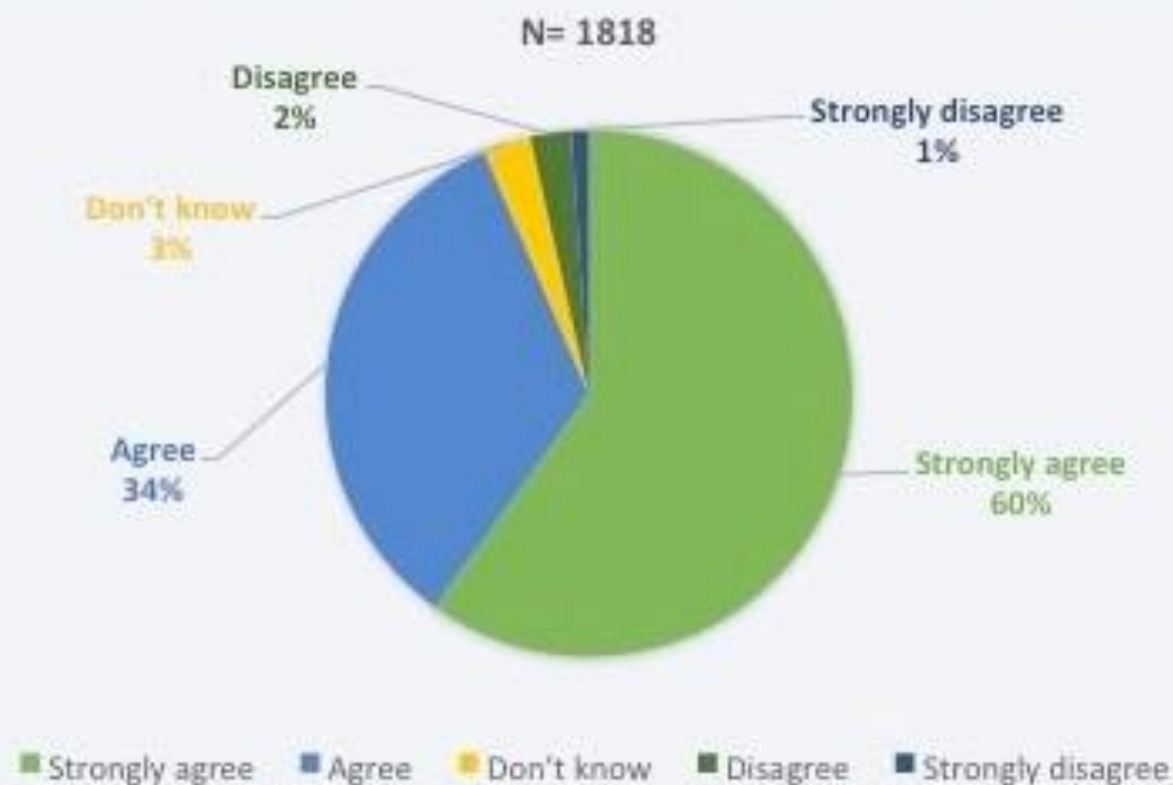

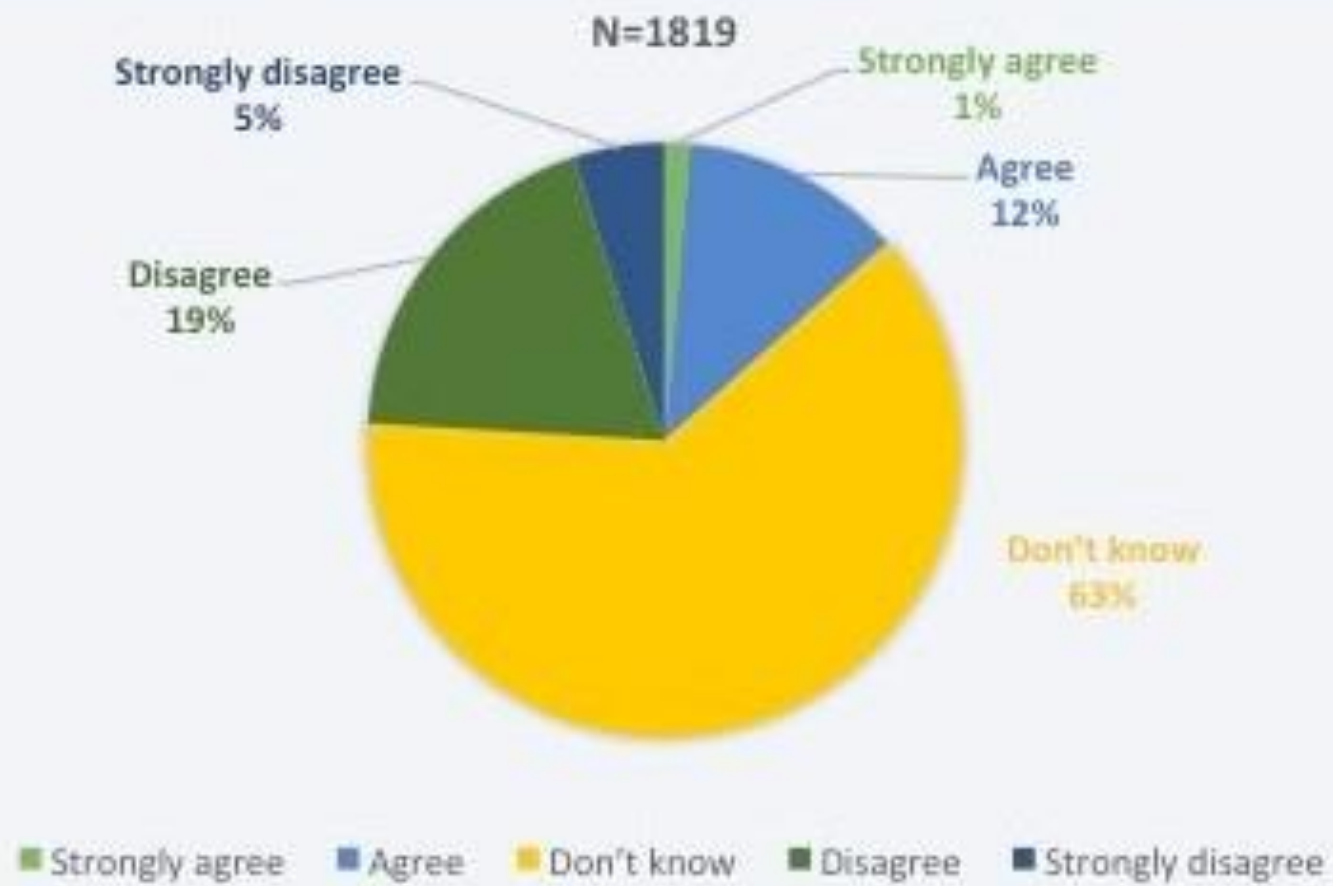
## WHAT KIND OF ENVIRONMENT DO PATIENTS PREFER AT THE END OF LIFE?



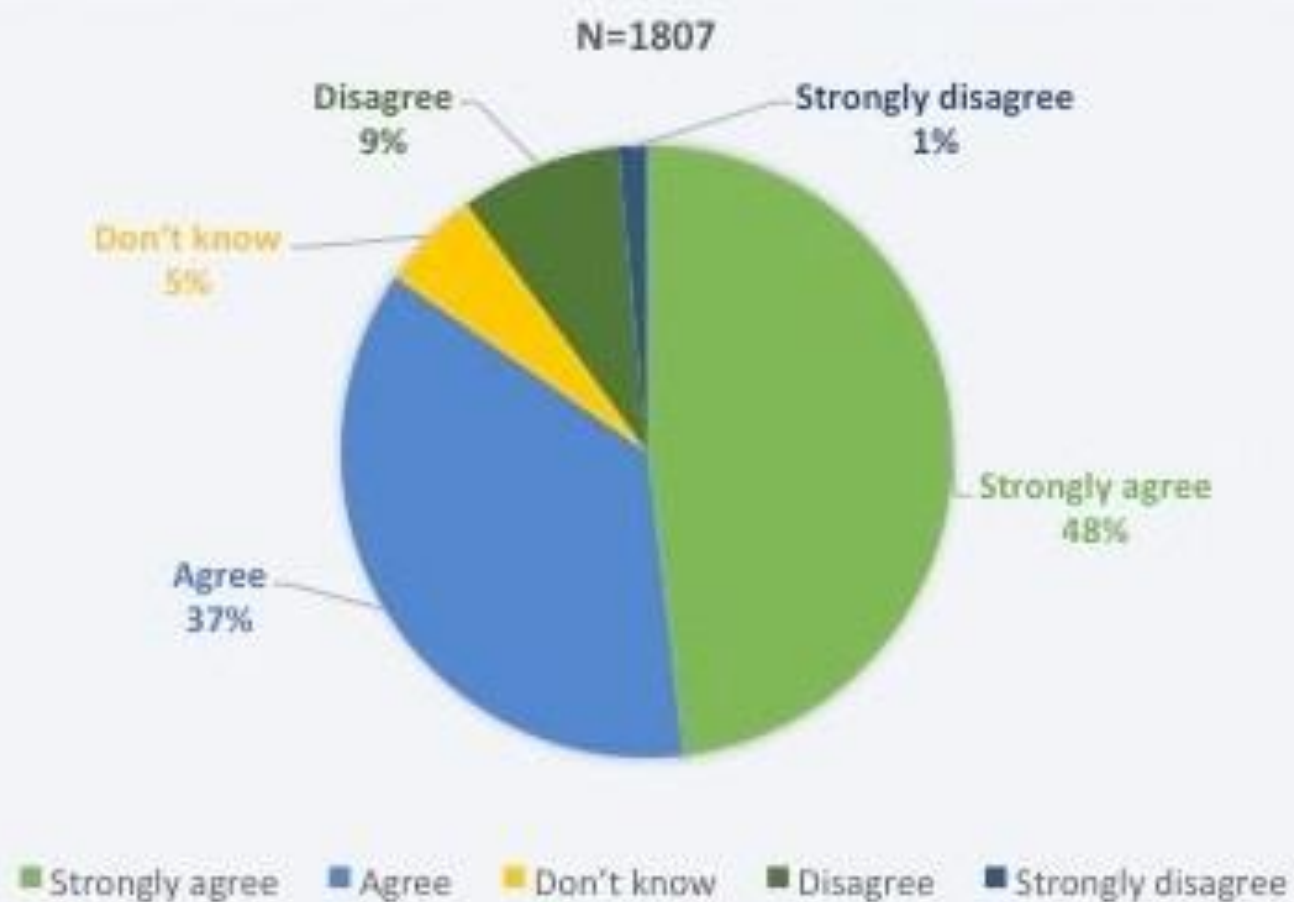

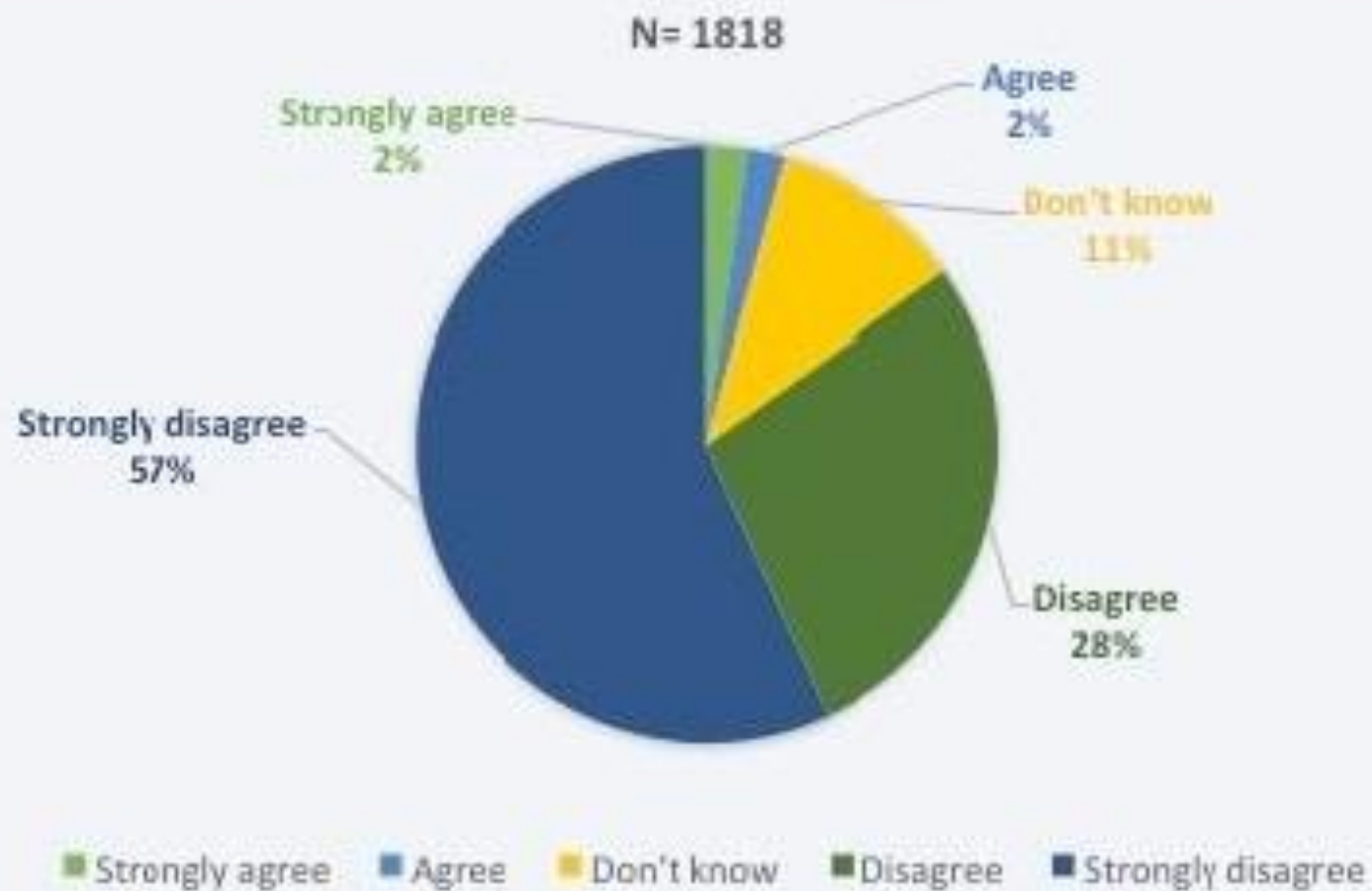
